




## HEARTH RESTAURANT OPENING AT THE HEATHMAN HOTEL IN KIRKLAND

The Heathman Hotel is taking "spring cleaning" to the next level this year. At the end of March, Trellis Restaurant, which opened in 2007, closed its doors for good. The space received a transforming remodel during Spring 2019, including the addition of a traditional hearth oven, the inspiration for its new name: Hearth Restaurant. Chef Adam Johnson says the casual restaurant will offer high-quality, locally sourced American cuisine items, including slow-roasted meats like bison short-ribs, house-made pickles, Hama Hama oysters, and a reinvented brunch menu serving banana buckwheat pancakes with banana custard and smoked maple syrup and a Dungeness crab omelet with bacon, tarragon, onions, and hollandaise sauce, among other items. Look for creative craft cocktails and taps of local beer and cider in the bar.
